Day 1 Depart USA Depart the USA on an overnight flight to Paris to begin your splendid experience in France. Meals and refreshments are served on board.

Day 2 Arrive in Paris Welcome to France's capital, Paris known as the "City of Light." After clearing customs and immigration, you will be met by your Aventura World tour representative. Then you will travel to your 5-star/deluxe river cruise vessel, your floating home for the next seven nights. There is just something magical about Paris! No matter what season, it is always a spectacular time to enjoy the City of Light. Packed with attractions, museums, and monuments – from the historical to the most modern and cosmopolitan, Paris is captivating, exciting, enchanting, romantic, and fun at every turn. Take some time to explore the city at your own pace. This evening you will be treated to a Welcome Cocktail Reception before dinner onboard. (D)

Day 3 Conflans Enjoy breakfast on board before you rise and shine in Conflans St. Honorine, at the confluence of the rivers Oise and Seine. Join a guided tour to the picturesque, riverside town of Auvers-sur-Oise, best known for inspiring 19th-century Impressionist and Post-Impressionist artists like Cezanne, Pissarro, and van Gogh. This postcard-perfect village is the resting place of Vincent van Gogh and was also home to many painters in the 1800s. An inspiration to many Impressionist masters, including Cezanne, and Daubigny. Here you will see firsthand the buildings and beautiful landscapes that inspired van Gogh's final works. Late this afternoon, depart Auvers-sur-Oise and head back to your river cruise vessel. (B,L,D)

Day 4 Rouen Wake to the day in Rouen with a full breakfast and then join a walking tour of the capital of the Normandy region. Stroll the colorful streets of Rouen and visit the town's breathtaking gothic cathedral that was the subject of many of Claude Monet's paintings. Walk past the city's iconic Gros-Horloge or Great Clock, gaze upon the modern Church of Joan of Arc that features magnificent 16th-century stained-glass windows and see the town's signature half-timbered buildings. This afternoon, take an optional guided tour to the Rouen Museum of Fine Arts with its impressive collection of impressionist paintings. Late this afternoon, your river cruise departs as your exploration continues northward. (B,L,D)

Day 5 Le Havre Start this fantastic new day with breakfast on board your deluxe river vessel and then head out to delve into the magic of Honfleur on a city tour. Next, you will enjoy a walk along the cliff-top paths of Étretat overlooking the sweeping coastline of Normandy. It's no wonder that these uniquely shaped rock formations carved from its white cliffs set against the sea have inspired so many works of art over the centuries. This afternoon, consider embarking on an optional guided tour to the nearby city of Honfleur, known for its picturesque oldworld harbor lined with 16th -18th-century multi-storied homes. This evening onboard the vessel, enjoy live music performed by local chanson singers. (B,L,D)





Day 6 Le Havre - Caudebec-en-Caux After breakfast on board, join your tour and step back in time. In Caudebec-en-Caux take time to see the gardens and houses that line the peaceful waterway, check out the historical center of town where you will see the town's 15th-century gothic style church of Notre Dame, or check out the local eateries. Experience a combination of rich culinary traditions and historic landmarks, including the closest harbor of Arromanches is linked with the liberation of Western Europe after World War II's D-Day. Arromanches were at the forefront of the Normandy landings. Its beach was one of the coastal areas selected to receive the man-made landing harbors, known as the Mulberry Harbors, during the invasion of France. These were pivotal in bringing an end to the Second World War, as they were designed in such a way that they could be floated across the English Channel to act as a temporary harbor for the D-Day Landings. Day 7 Les Andelys - Vernon - Mantes-La-Jolie Savor a delicious breakfast this morning onboard and then head out at your leisure to explore Les Andelys. Relish a refreshing walk up to Château Gaillard, built by Richard the Lionheart in 1198 overlooking one of the most beautiful meanders of the River Seine. Take time to tour the white stone remains of the English king's stronghold that was built at the end of the 12th century on a limestone promontory. Nearby exploring is offered to delve into charming places such as the small town of Giverny, where Claude Monet had his magnificent gardens and home. Have lunch on board your deluxe river vessel, then join an excursion to Château de Malmaison, the former residence of Joséphine and Napoleon Bonaparte. This evening in Mantes-La-Jolie, a festive Captain's Gala Dinner is planned for your ultimate enjoyment. (B,L,D)

Day 8 Paris Have breakfast on board and get ready to savor the "joie de vivre" – the joy of living – in Paris today! This morning you will embark on an enchanting Paris – City Lights tour. You will be mesmerized its famed attractions, including such sites as the Arc de Triomphe, Champs-Elysees, Notre Dame, Montmartre's Basilique du Sacré-Cœur, and the Eiffel Tower. The endless number of things to do and places to see means that everyone can find something fascinating to discover in this singular, magical, and majestic city. Let your imagination wander as you pass through the streets of this capital, which are imbued with the memory of those who shaped the history of France: Joan of Arc, Louis XIV, Louis XVI, and Napoleon Bonaparte. In your sightseeing program, you will, of course, see the most important monuments in Paris. The sightseeing program includes the incomparable Eiffel Tower, Les Invalides, famous as the burial place of Emperor Napoleon I, the fabulous Louvre Museum, the famous and elegant Champs-Elysées, the Jardin des Tuileries, former palace gardens laid out in the French style and much more. Revel in the rest of the day at leisure and spend the night onboard your deluxe river vessel in the French capital. (B,L,D)

Day 9 Reims - Palace of Versailles Tour After breakfast, you tour the Palace of Versailles. The Palace was built as a relatively modest hunting retreat for Louis XIII in 1623. Still, his successor—Louis XIV—expanded it and turned it into the symbol of luxury and extravagance that we know today. The Palace we see today was completed in 1710 and remains one of the most famous palaces in Europe. See highlights like the Hall of Mirrors, the Royal Apartments, and the expansive gardens. Enjoy some free time to wander as you please, and even watch a musical fountain display if you're there at the right time. Return to Reims this afternoon, check in to tour the hotel, and enjoy some free time to explore. (B)

Day 10 Reims The day is yours at leisure. There is no end to the breathtaking sites you can explore on your own or take an optional tour to the Champagne Region. Champagne lovers—this is the tour for you. Spend a day exploring and tasting your way around the idyllic Champagne region of France. Visit the UNESCO-listed Champagne Avenue at Epernay, see the historic village of Hautvillers, and visit a vineyard to sample delicious Champagne. (B)
