All applications and supporting materials must be <u>received by noon, Monday, April 13, 2020</u>, to **be considered.** The selection committee will make its decision by the end of April. Each applicant will be contacted shortly thereafter. All applicants will be contacted. Scholarships are made only for the program/school described in your application. Applicants who change their school/ program after the BIAWC's scholarship decisions are made will forfeit their scholarships.

## **DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS**

Scholarship checks will be issued directly to the applicant's school of choice, to be used for tuition, fees and/or books during the upcoming academic year. Scholarships are not available to pay off previous student loans.
