This letter serves as an invitation to submit a project proposal for our upcoming Leadership Springfield class.

Every year, Leadership Springfield brings together 30-40 promising leaders from the private, nonprofit, and public sectors to facilitate leadership development and encourage community engagement. The program is comprised of 3 hour programs over a fourteen-week period that include community site visits, discussion groups, conversations with leaders and other activities.

Participants also engage in group projects with the primary goal of enabling local non-profit organizations to extend beyond their current resources and tackle problems, issues, or goals with the assistance of creative minds and the manpower of our Leadership Springfield class. Some examples of past projects have included volunteer program development, marketing plan assistance, promotional brochure development, website enhancement, and surveys of educational needs in the community.

Five to seven projects will be selected for this year's Class, which begins in early September.
