PROGRAM OUTLINE

The program begins with a general orientation in December, followed by a mandatory weekend retreat in January. Class sessions are held one day a month February through November, followed by a graduation ceremony in December. Monthly sessions are conducted by local leaders and professionals from business, civic, governmental, and academic areas.
