

 Nearly all losses were from ambulatory HC services (-1,442)


But all sectors in HC also declined




Largest Recent Changes (2016-2017)

- Specialty trade contractors, +155 jobs
- Administrative and support svc, +25 jobs
- Personal laundry services, +17 jobs
- Nonstore retailers, +13 jobs
- Ambulatory health care, +13 jobs
- Credit intermediation, +12 jobs
- Nursing and residential care, +12 jobs









3.9% Unemployment rate in 2017, not last seen since '97-'01




Wage Pressures

OTY Median Hourly Wage Growth in Sherburne County




Median Hourly Wages in Sherburne County, 2016
