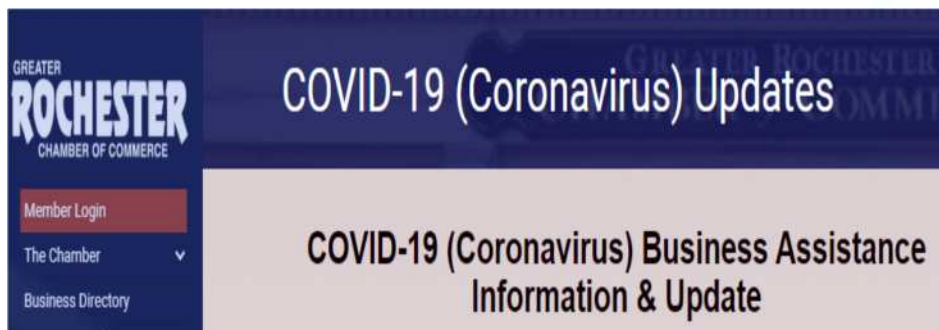

GOFERR ROADMAP FOR RECOVERY

Governor Sununu announced the Governor's Office for Emergency Relief and Recovery (GOFERR) will be providing \$595 million of relief funds from the \$1.25 billion federal funds from the CARES act that NH received.

- **Healthcare Relief Fund:** \$50,000,000
- **Non-Profit Relief Fund:** \$60,000,000
- **Child Care:** \$25,000,000
- **Main Street Relief Fund:** \$400,000,000 - Deadline has passed
- **Farm and Food:** \$15,000,000
- **Public Higher Education Relief Fund:** \$15,000,000
- **Business Finance Authority Safe Harbor Forgivable Loans:** \$30,000,000

Governor Chris Sununu Extends Stay at Home 2.0

Governor Chris Sununu announced the Stay at Home 2.0 order that has been extended to June 15. In the meantime, steps are being taken to reopen the economy in a phased approach. 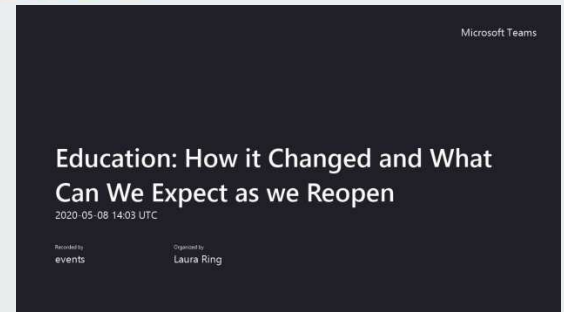

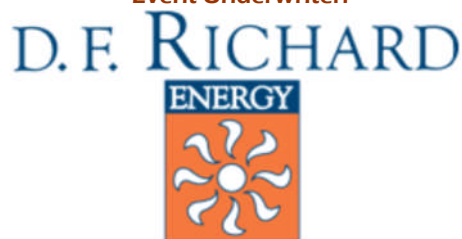
