PPP LOANS EXTENDED TO MAY 31, 2021


The Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) is a loan designed to provide a direct incentive for small businesses to keep their workers on payroll. Borrowers may be eligible for PPP loan forgiveness.

The SBA is **currently offering PPP_loans until May 31, 2021**. President Biden announced <u>program changes</u> to make access to PPP loans more equitable.

<u>First Draw PPP loans</u>: If you have not received a PPP loan before, First Draw PPP loans are available to you.

<u>Second Draw PPP loans</u>: If you have previously received a PPP loan, certain businesses are eligible for a Second Draw PPP loan.
