

Starting May 23, 2021, NH Employment Security will require NH residents collecting unemployment benefits to prove they are looking for work. This returns us to the pre-Covid-19 pandemic policy, which had been waived in 2020 so people could be safe. To assist people in their effort to return to work, NH Works Job Centers will be opening to the public by May 10, 2021 and 10 Virtual Job Fairs have been scheduled.


