Mixer Host Doing Well in New Location

Business is Booming for Begnal Motors

Owner Larry Begnal says relocating his auto dealership near the Thruway circle in the town of Ulster two years ago has been a game-changer.

"It's been remarkable." Begnal says. "We've seen a tremendous increase in business. We're up probably 30 percent in business. It's easy for people to get in and out. There are no more parking woes. Everything is just working out perfectly."

Begnal will mark the anniversary of the move by hosting the Chamber's next networking Mixer from 5-7 p.m. Oct. 17 at his dealership, located at 129 state Route 28.

"We've been here two years now in our new building, so it's kind of an anniversary for us," Begnal said. "Chamber Mixers are a good way to get the community involved in local events. Everyone always has a good time.

"It's a great chance for the community to come in say hello and for us to say hello to them and for them to see our operation. It's just a nice, easy

way to showcase your building. You get hundreds of people in here that you may not see otherwise."

Begnal said The Chateau will cater the event and refreshments will be provided by JK's Wine & Liquor and Keegan Ales.

"We're going to have some door prizes for some large-screen TVs," he said. "It will just be a nice evening to get out."

Begnal Motors—which sells Chrysler, Fiat, Dodge, Jeep and Ram vehicles— is now in a 34,000-square-foot building. Before the move, the dealership operated out of 10,000 square feet on Albany Avenue in Kingston and many of its services were spread out in separate buildings. Parking was also tight, but the new dealership provides plenty of space.

"Everything is in one place now," Begnal says. "We have our oil change area and 5-star fast service is open seven days a week. We also offer state inspections in there, which we couldn't do before. It was in a separate building. So this is one-stop service.

Begnal also offers 11 acres of property to display vehicles, compared to 2 acres at the old location. The dealership has about 400 vehicles at any one time.

Meanwhile. waiting area service features free Wi-Fi and computer plug-ins, three 50inch televisions and a "Junior Jeepers" room for youngsters that includes kid-friendly activities such as a paint wall.

"We keep everything on an even keel." Begnal said. "We offer

regular sales and service all the time and keep our prices low and it keeps people coming back."

Begnal said his dealership, which employs 50 local residents, is definitely benefitting from the changing tastes of U.S.

"Small cars have died off," he said, "People aren't buying small cars anymore. They're looking for crossovers or sport

> utility vehicles. That's what their main thrust is and that's right in our wheelhouse. Jeep has the Renegade and the Cherokee, the Compass, the Grand Cherokee. the Wrangler and the Gladiator. The Gladiator pickup just came out and we've sold a ton of those. Everybody really loves that vehicle. We're right in the wheelhouse of where the nation is heading, product-wise."

Begnal said Jeeps are his best sellers, followed closely by Ram trucks.

"The Jeeps just keep going," he said, "The Wrangler has been done over this year and everybody loves that. They just sell themselves. Jeep is the no. 1 sports utility vehicle in the Northeast."

Begnal said people love the utility nature of the larger vehicles.

'If you try to get a bunch of stuff in the trunk of a small car, it doesn't fit," he said. "These other vehicles have got a lot more versatility and we have them."

Todd said each of the seven candidates will be given a chance to speak to the audience and discuss their background, their reasons for running, their vision for the future and more. Due to the number of candidates and time constraints, there will not be an opportunity for questions from the floor, but all candidates have been asked to stay after the breakfast, from 9-10 a.m., to meet one-on-one with attendees, hear their concerns and answer

The League of Women Voters will facilitate the event, Todd

The candidates will appear for the following offices:

County Executive: Incumbent Democrat Pat Rvan and Republican-Conservative Jack Haves, both of whom hail from Gardiner in southern Ulster County, are facing off again. This time, the stakes are a full four-year term as County Executive.

Rvan and Haves opposed each other this spring to serve until the end of 2019 and fill out the term of former County Executive Mike Hein, who resigned to take a state job. Rvan won that election.

Ryan, a tech entrepreneur, U.S. Army veteran and graduate of the U.S. Military Academy at West Point, is holding office for the first time. He ran unsuccessfully for Congress in 2018. Haves, who is the chairman of the Ulster County Conservative Party and retired from the New York State Police, served as town of Gardiner supervisor in 2002-03 and was an Ulster County legislator from 2010-11. He ran unsuccessfully for the NYS Assembly in 2016.

County Comptroller: Democrat March Gallagher and Republican Lisa Cutten are vying to serve the last two years of the four-year term of former County Comptroller Elliott Auerbach, a Democrat who resigned to take a state job.

An attorney and Rosendale resident, Gallagher had been President of the non-profit Community Foundations of the Hudson Valley. She also worked for Hudson Valley Pattern for Progress and led the county's Office of Economic Development. Cutten, a certified public accountant, was most recently the director of the Ulster County Office of Accountability,

Compliance and Efficiency. The Kingston resident has held numerous municipal finance offices, including deputy county budget director, county auditor and Kingston city treasurer.

District Attorney: Republican Michael Kavanagh and Democrat David Clegg are running to succeed curren Republican District Attorney D. Holley Carnright, who is no seeking re-election. The winner will serve a four-year term.

Kayanagh, of West Saugerties, has been a prosecutor and defense attorney for almost 20 years in Dutchess and Ulste counties, including the last four years as Carnright's Chie Assistant. He is the son of longtime Ulster County Distric Attorney Michael Kavanagh. Clegg, a Woodstock resident with a law office in Kingston, brings more than 40 years of experience to the race, including nine years as an Assistant Public Defende for Ulster County. He ran unsuccessfully for Congress in the 19th District in 2018.

County Judge: Democrat Bryan Rounds, a town of Ulste resident, is running unopposed to replace incumbent Republican Ulster County Judge Donald Williams, who is not seeking re election. A former Assistant District Attorney in Albany, Rounds specializes in criminal defense with the Kingston law firm Rounds & Rounds. Rounds will serve a 10-year term.

This month's YUP Spotlight focuses on one of the oldest and most popular fall attractions in Ulster County, Kelder's Farm. Kelder's Farm was established in 1779 and has grown to become a popular agricultural destination for families to take a step away from the hustle and bustle of life.

The Kelder family farm started as a small idea and grew into one of the Hudson Valley's most unique experiences. It spans over 100 acres of seasonal produce; uses community supported agricultural practices, and facilitates an educational program for

many school children in Ulster County. In the last 200 years this family has farmed chickens, pigs and dairy cattle, en route to becoming a premier agri-tourism destination. They are an award-winning sustainable farm that hosts friendly farm animals, homegrown mini-golf, a massive, kid-pleasing jumping pillow, and the World's Largest Garden Gnome (Guinness Book of World Records 2009).

On this small farm just 90 miles north of New York City, Chris and Jackie Kelder had the vision to turn their portion of the beautiful farmland into something everyone could enjoy and appreciate. And now, John Kelder, the next generation, has joined them to help carry on the family tradition. What started out as a dairy farm and a few rows of strawberries, with an old homemade sign, has quickly turned into a healthy seasonal attraction that people from miles away visit year after year-that's how Kelder's Farm has blossomed over the centuries. - Written by John Kelder

Ulster County's Best On Display

15th Annual Business Awards Unveiled

Michael Bernholz, owner of Pine Ridge Dude Ranch in Kerhonkson and Hudson Valley Appraisal Co. in Port Ewen, is Ulster County's Business Person of the Year.

Bernholz, a prominent local realtor, is one of eight honorees by the Chamber and Ulster County Economic Development Alliance in announcing their 15th-annual Business Recognition Awards. Chamber President Ward Todd said the awards annually recognize Ulster County business leaders, businesses and organizations that are leaders in their sectors, have achieved outstanding results, or shown dedication and commitment to furthering business and the quality of life in Ulster County.

Bernholz has owned the Pine Ridge Dude Ranch for almost two years and has invested more than \$2 million renovating the attraction, which has been recognized as a top family and resort location by several prominent groups and publications. Bernholtz employs more than 100 people across his various businesses, including Hudson Valley Appraisal, which has

been in Port Ewen since 1983, as well as a marina in Kingston, a Shokan shopping plaza and numerous other residential and commercial properties.

This year's other honorees include:

Business of the Year—Trailways – Pine Hill, Adirondack, New York, the largest intercity bus company in the state, employs more than 400 people and transports travelers more than 8 million miles a year. The company recently renovated its 1970s flagship terminal in Kingston. The terminal in Kingston handles about 40 buses a day and 250,000 passengers a year. Founded in 1926, the company operates today under five brands, including Adirondack Trailways, Pine Hill Trailways, New York Trailways, NeOn Bus and LINE.

Small Business of the Year—Bailey Pottery Equipment, known around the world for its innovative and quality-built pottery equipment, began in Midtown Kingston 40 years ago this year with one employee. The company now employs 29. Jim Bailey started the company out of a rented factory space, but he and wife, Anne, grew a mail-order catalogue business into one that occupies a 28,000-square-foot business on Ten Broeck Avenue in Kingston and has expanded to more space on Foxhall Avenue.

Emerging Young Leader—Christopher Bowers joined the Reis Group in 2015 after graduating from SUNY Oneonta and has made a name for himself in the local insurance industry as someone who treats his clients and their businesses as his own. Bowers also serves on the Ulster County Regional Chamber of Commerce's Board of Directors and is Chairman of the



Membership Committee. Among his many volunteer positions is helping his mother, Rondout Valley Savings Bank President Cheryl Bowers, run the Lions Club's Thanksgiving dinner for the blind.

Tourism Business of the Year—The industrial-chic Senate Garage, located in Uptown Kingston, has been one of Ulster County's premier tourist attractions since opening in 2015. The venue has hosted weddings (with the historic Senate House just outside), concerts and political events since being renovated from an industrial space into a luxurious event venue by owners Don and Judy Tallerman.

<u>Commitment</u> to the <u>Community</u>—Ulster Literacy Association, founded in 1979 around a kitchen table, helps 400 people a year learn to read with the help of 200 eager volunteers, many of whom are seniors. Ulster Literacy, through a variety of programs, teaches English and literacy skills on farms, in the county jail, homes and wherever someone needs help.

The Heritage Award—The Savona Family, which owns four local restaurants, has been an integral part of Ulster County's business community for 40 years. Patriarchs "Manny and Cell" left Brooklyn in 1972 looking for a new place to raise their family. They stopped after two hours in Kingston and found "home." They opened their first pizzeria on Albany Avenue in Kingston not long after arriving and the rest is history. The family tradition of dining excellence now continues under sons Stephen and Daniel.

Len Cane Heart of Ulster County Award—Tony Marmo, the owner of Normann Staffing in Kingston, is one of the busiest men in Ulster County with a true heart for others. Besides helping

people find work at his day job, Marmo's volunteer resume is impressive: He is a 35-year member of Rotary International and is currently the Rotary District Governor Elect for District 7210, an eight-county region in the Hudson Valley. He co-founded the Ulster County Italian American Foundation and serves on the Board of the YMCA of Kingston & Ulster County and the Ulster County Workforce Development Board. He is a volunteer cohost on Kingston Community Radio and has been since 2004. His past service includes nearly a decade on the Board of the Ulster County Regional Chamber of Commerce including two years as Chairman as well as two terms on the Chamber Foundation Board. He has served on the Boards of the New York/New Jersey American Cancer Society, Ulster Performing Arts Center, Mid-Hudson American Heart Association, Junior Achievement in Ulster County and the Alzheimer's Association. He is the former President and CEO of Kingston Hospital.

"The Chamber would like to congratulate the recipients and offer special thanks to those who provided the nominations and the independent panel for the final selections," said Todd. "These Best of Ulster County awards are peer-driven and an excellent way for the business community to recognize outstanding efforts."

The award recipients will be honored at a dinner Thursday, Oct. 24 at Diamond Mills Hotel & Tavern, 25 S. Partition St. in Saugerties. Tickets are \$125 each and the dinner begins with cocktails at 5:30 p.m.
