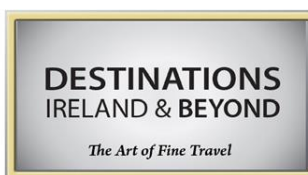

Overview Itinerary with Pricing and Inclusions

March 26, Sat: JFK-Dublin Ireland. Dinner & Overnight on board flight.

March 27, Sun: Arrive Dublin, meet your Driver Guide in the arrivals hall. Drive to the West Coast, Visit **Clonmacnoise** before arriving in Galway for you 2-night stay at The House Hotel (or similar). **Dinner at your hotel.**

March 28, Mon: EXCURSION TO CONNEMARA This morning we will journey to **Connemara & visit Kylemore Abbey**, stunningly located in the Kylemore Pass in Connemara. Enjoy a bread making demonstration and lunch at Dan O'Hara's Homestead, overlooked by the majestic Twelve Ben Mountains, this agri-tourism enterprise incorporates a heritage centre and Farmhouse. **(B, L) Evening at Leisure in Galway.**

March 29, Tues: DEPART FOR COUNTY KERRY, VISIT CLIFFS OF MOHER ENROUTE. Situated on the Atlantic Ocean and bordering **The Burren** region, the **Cliffs of Moher** are one of Ireland's most spectacular sights. Standing 230 meters above the ocean at their highest point and 8KM long, The Cliffs boast one of the most amazing views in Ireland. Take the ferry over the **Shannon Estuary** into County Kerry for your 2-night stay at Randles Hotel (or Similar). **(B, D) Dinner at your hotel.**

March 30, Weds: TOUR THE RING OF KERRY **The Ring of Kerry** (166k) is the most famous and panoramic route in Ireland. The astonishing beauty of this large peninsula, Iveragh, comes from the great diversity of its scenery, which offers incessant contrasts. En route around the Ring take in spectacular scenery mountains, peat bogs, lakes and magnificent views of the Atlantic Ocean as one travels along the coast road. Leaving Killarney we pass through **Killorglin**, famous for its **Puck Fair**, then to **Glenbeigh** where the cliff road affords panoramic views of the **Dingle Peninsula and Dingle Bay**. **(B) Evening at leisure in Killarney.**

March 31, Thurs: KILLARNEY TO KINSALE, VISIT WEST CORK. En-route enjoy a visit to **Garinish Island** on the Harbour Queen Ferry which provides service to the gardens of **Ilnacullin** on Garinish Island. Garinish is a unique island that plays host to a multitude of plant variations, and the blanket of summer coloring which covers the island creates a rainbow of color. Visit **Clonakilty Distillery**, this new distillery opened in 2018.

Three gleaming copper pot stills are an inspiring sight to behold. Experience the touch, sounds and smells of a real working distillery. Overnight in **Kinsale** at The Trident Hotel (or similar). Kinsale is known locally as **Ireland Gourmet Capital**. **(B) Evening at Leisure.**

April 01, Fri: KINSALE TO DUBLIN, VISIT THE ROCK OF CASHEL: This morning enjoy a 90-minute Guided Heritage Walking Tour of Kinsale. Kinsale was a strategic naval base during the conflict for New World Treasure, it was also the beachhead for the last Spanish Armada leading to the Battle of Kinsale in 1601. Next we visit **The Rock of Cashel**, possibly the most photographed sights in Ireland. The Rock of Cashel towers over the town of Cashel in **County Tipperary**, from its perch on a 200 foot high outcrop of limestone. Once the seat of the Kings of Munster, St. Patrick visited the rock in 450AD. Onward to Dublin for your 2-night stay at The Address (or similar) **(B) Evening at Leisure in Dublin.**

April 02, Sat: DUBLINS FAIR CITY! Enjoy a Panoramic Tour of Dublin and tour of the Guinness Storehouse. **The Guinness Brewery** is Europe's largest stout producing brewery and home to the Guinness Storehouse. Opened in 1904, the Storehouse was an operational plant for fermenting and storing Guinness. Today it houses a very fine exhibition dedicated to the Guinness story. Visitors will discover what goes into making a pint of Guinness-the ingredients, the brewing process, the time, the craft and the passion.

This evening enjoy Dinner & Entertainment with traditional Irish Music, Song & Dancing. **(B, D)**
