# New York City

<b>Statute/Regulatory Section</b>	1 RCNY 3005-11
<b>State Regulation</b>	Yes
<b>Exclusions from Regulation</b>	coin-op; locomotives weighing more than 7 tons, operating on track of any length with 3 foot or greater gauge and weighing 60 pounds per yard.
<b>State Mandated Inspection (State / Insurance)</b>	Yes— City inspectors
<b>Frequency of Required Inspections</b>	Seasonal: 2 inspections per year - 1 prior to initial use during the season, 1 90-120 days later. Year-Round - 3 inspections 90-120 days apart from each other.
<b>Minimum Insurance Requirement</b>	\$1M general liability per occurrence \$2.5M aggregate
