BY CHARLES DICKENS ADAPTED BY SHANNON ROOD & THE GSC THEATRE PROGRAM


A classic tale of compassion toward other and change of self, "A CHRISTMAS CAROL" by Charles Dickens recounts the story of Ebenezer Scrooge.



## SIX SIGMA BLACK BELT TRAINING


