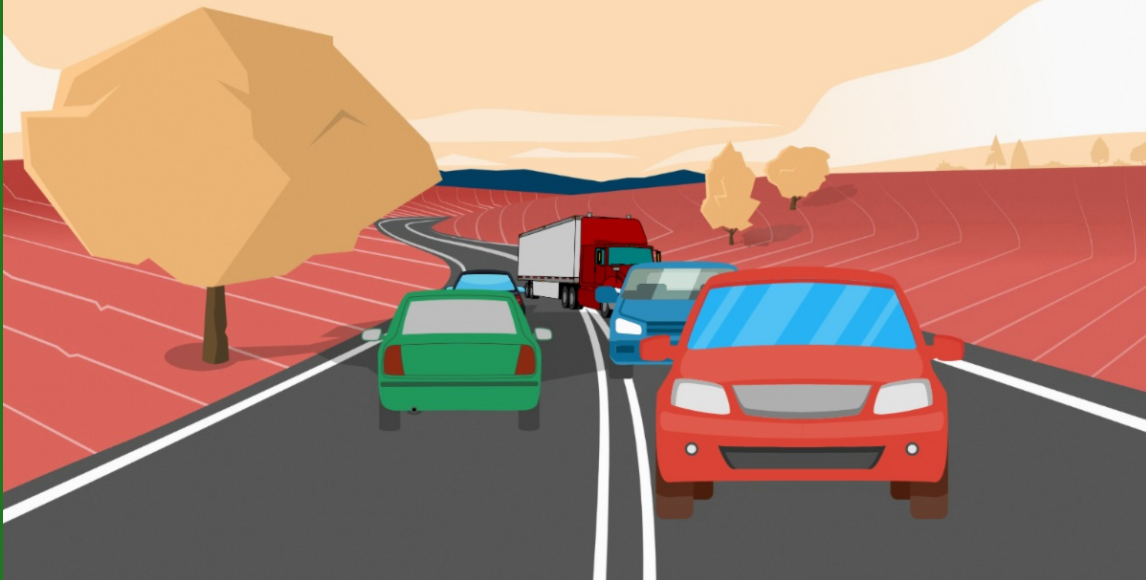

Thank you to the City of Jackson Downtown Development Authority for awarding the Chamber of Commerce with a \$1000 facade grant to help with the cost prepping and painting the Mesquite building for the mural project Chanse and Chase Taylor are working hard on the murals. Weather permitting, they should be completed by June 1, 2023.



More Murals Coming Soon!

We have more beautiful art coming to Jackson! Get ready to view some new murals on the side of the Mesquite Building at the corner of Mulberry Street and 3rd Street. Butts County has secured another Vibrant Communities Grant through the Georgia Council for the Arts to help pay for the murals. Securing the grant and additional funds for this project is a collaborative effort between the Butts County Chamber of Commerce, the Butts County Administration, and the Georgia Council for the Arts.

The owner of the Mesquite Building, Mr. Humberto Colin, has granted permission for the artwork to be displayed on the building. K.P. Painting, LLC has prepped the side of the building with a lovely shade from the City of Jackson's approved Historical Collection of colors. The Mayor and City Council voted to approve the murals. The artwork will be completed by local artists ArtbyChanse&Chase, LLC who have completed other work in Butts County.

This program is sponsored in part by the Georgia Council for the Arts through appropriations of the Georgia General Assembly. Georgia Council for the Arts also receives support from its partner agency – the National Endowment for the Arts.

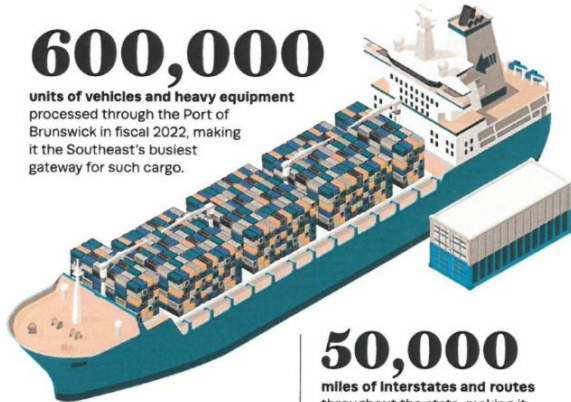


Move It!

Planes, trains, ships, semis, and more—Georgia's transportation system is a force to be reckoned with. Here are some of the state's most impressive transportation metrics.

600,000

units of vehicles and heavy equipment processed through the Port of Brunswick in fiscal 2022, making it the Southeast's busiest gateway for such cargo.

miles of freight railroad tracks conveying cargo across Georgia.



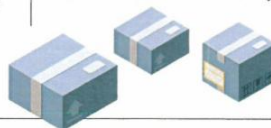
10,000

nautical miles, on average, a vessel travels to reach the Port of Savannah, which served 1,997 ships in its 2022 fiscal year.



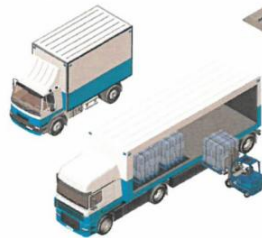
5,763,711

miles of interstates and routes throughout the state, making it the nation's 10th-largest state transportation network.

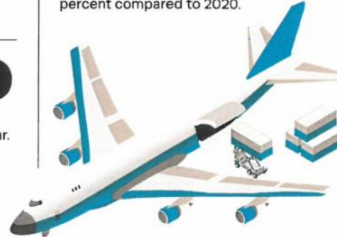
