INTRODUCTION

Will County is working diligently to vaccinate all residents against COIVD-19. More than 50 different providers are working in conjunction with the Health Department to provide this vaccine to anyone living or working in Will County who is interested.

- Will County EMA is currently vetting Mass Vaccination Sites to expand clinics throughout the county

 schedule appointments.
- 5,408 vaccines coordinated and administered by the Will County Health Department last week at both on-site clinic and through Strike Teams.

DATA

91,725 doses have been administered.

23,676 people have been fully vaccinated.

3.42% of the population has been vaccinated to date.

Will County is currently ranked #4 in the State for amount of vaccine administered.

Reported Inventory at Will County Health Department is 1,355.

Will County continues to see decrease of positivity rate. Region 7 is 4.5% as of 2/22/21.

Will County's seven day average doses administered are 3,015.
