**Important Information**: No throw outs or alcoholic beverages are allowed by the parade entries. Please include names of key person who will be on your entry or those leading bands, so our announcers can give them proper recognition. **All participants are strongly encouraged to use music in their entries.** 

#### 82<sup>nd</sup> ANNUAL WESTERN WEEK CHAMBER PARADE INFORMATION AND REGULATIONS

<u>Please familiarize yourself with this information and share it with your parade participants</u>

- All entries MUST be operated in a legal, safe and ethical manner and comply with law enforcement, parade committee directions and community standards of good taste. Any lewd or lascivious behavior will not be tolerated and will be grounds for expulsion from the parade. The consumption of drugs or alcohol by parade participants is strictly prohibited.
- Commercial entries may display only the name of the business/organization submitted on the original entry form.
- All marchers, walkers and riders MUST remain with their unit in their assigned position in the staging area and proceed in a steady and continuous manner during the parade, maintaining a minimum of 30ft. between entries.
- Smoking in/on units is not permitted.

Signature:

- No entry may exceed 65ft in length or 14ft in height.
- All towed entries MUST have an approved safety chain between the tow vehicle and the unit/float.
- All entries MUST have sufficient fuel to operate gas-powered generators. Generators should not be started until the parade begins in order to preserve fuel. DO NOT add fuel to hot generators!
- All floats and miscellaneous entries MUST have easily accessible entrance and exit for participants/riders and a clear, unobstructed view for drivers/operators.
- Drivers MUST have a valid driver's license and proof of insurance.
- Objects, such as candy, gum, flowers, samples, coupons, flyers, etc. may NOT be thrown from entry.
- In the event of an emergency, vehicle breakdown or equipment failure, entries should be moved promptly away from or off of the parade route so as not to impede parade traffic, spectator view or emergency vehicles. All issues of public safety rest expressly with the Beeville Police Department.
- All entries MUST disperse quickly and safely from the break-up area at the end of the parade route. There will be no "holding area" for floats or miscellaneous units at the end of the parade. <u>Stopping</u>, <u>blocking units behind you from proceeding or unloading participants is NOT permitted</u> until instructed to do so by parade officials.
- Attention Mounted Groups: The following qualifications must be observed: 1. Parade limited to 10 organized mounted groups, maximum of 20 riders per group 2. Must be judged 3. Minimum dress requirements; hats long sleeve shirts, neckerchiefs, ties, or vests, jeans and boots 4. Horse and tack must be in good condition 5. One rider per horse 6. Horse drawn vehicles must be entered separately. All requirements must be met in order to participate.

<u>ALL "Car Club" vehicles MUST have proof of liability insurance coverage.</u> Fire extinguishers are required for each vehicle. <u>NO nitrous oxide bottles allowed.</u> All "Car Club" entries must be in "show condition". Limit of four vehicles per "Car Club" entry (one picture of each vehicle must be submitted with entry form). <u>All vehicles will be inspected for safety during line-up.</u>
