
National Ratings - RCP Average (August 24- 31, 2023)








New Hampshire Ratings - RCP Average (July 13 – Aug 16, 2023)




South Carolina Ratings - RCP Average (June 13 – Aug 19, 2023)






RCP August Polling Averages with Democratic Incumbent





Right Direction/Wrong Track


Do you think the country is going in the right direction, or is it on the wrong track?




Biden Approval Since Inauguration by Party ID

Do you approve or disapprove of the way Joe Biden is handling each?





Biden Personal Favorability










Senate Races – Charlie Cook's Predictions







Governor's Races – Charlie Cook's Predictions




'23 and '24 Governor's Races – Charlie Cook's Predictions

Trump vs. Biden, with slight edge to Trump Senate, edge to GOP House, edge to GOP Governors, at least one GOP pickup




What It Means

 - Right to Abortion Amendment on ballot in November
- Maine:
 - Pine Tree Power Initiative on ballot in November




Abortion



Democratic share of major party vote among nonwhite voters




2020 Reapportionment Results




Political Advertising by Media Type






Biden-Trump County Vote Comparisons – 2020 Land Area




Biden-Trump County Vote Comparisons – 2020 Population




The Winds of Change – 2016 to 2020




Voting Law Changes in 2021




