


MEET THE SPEAKERS

GOVERNOR KAY IVEY

Governor Kay Ivey became the 54th Governor of Alabama in 2017. A native of Camden in Wilcox County, she embarked on a career of public service to benefit her fellow Alabamians. During her time as governor, Alabama has seen record high employment and its lowest jobless rate. Her focus on economic development has attracted over \$18 billion in capital investment and 44,000 new jobs. She is committed to offering economic development opportunities to rural Alabama and the metro regions alike.

ROGER TUTTEROW, HENSSLER FINANCIAL ENDOWED CHAIR, DIRECTOR OF THE ECONOMETRIC CENTER AND PROFESSOR OF ECONOMICS, KENNESAW STATE UNIVERSITY

Roger Tutterow is Professor of Economics at Kennesaw State University where he holds the Henssler Financial Endowed Chair. His analysis of the economic, business and political environments have been featured in a variety of media including Wall Street Journal, Financial Times, Business Week, Forbes, USA Today and many more! In addition to his work in academia, Dr. Tutterow has served as a consultant on financial economics and statistical modeling for corporate clients ranging from Fortune 500 companies to closely held businesses.

GREG BARKER, EDPA

Greg Barker became president of Alabama's Economic Development Partnership in June 2020. Before this, he held leadership positions at Alabama Power for 18 years, advancing from the Economic and Community Development department to executive vice president. He also led economic development groups like Calhoun County Economic Development Authority and the Metropolitan Development Board. Greg contributed to key state initiatives such as the Alabama Economic Development Alliance and the Alabama Science & Technology Roadmap. He's currently on various boards, including the University of Alabama's Harbert Institute for Innovation and Entrepreneurship, Opportunity Alabama, and Innovation Depot.

REPRESENTATIVE ANTHONY DANIELS

Anthony Daniels is an Alabama State Representative for the 53rd District, known for his advocacy in education and community service. Graduating cum laude from Alabama A&M University in elementary education, he later obtained a Master's in special education from Alabama A&M University and an education fundraising certification from Dartmouth College. As former chairman of the National Education Association (NEA) Student Program, he played a key role in passing the College Cost and Reduction Act of 2007. His commitment to education continued through positions such as Chairman of Transportation in Huntsville Mayor Tommy Battle's Economic Sustainability Council and State Board of Directors member for the Alabama Education Association. Beyond politics, he served as Corporate and Foundations Relations officer at his Alma mater and is the COO of Premiere

Dental. Honored as Alabama State Legislator of the Year in 2015, Anthony remains active in various organizations and stands as a symbol of dedication to education, community, and family.

JAMES PROCTOR, II, MCWANE

James M. Proctor, II, is the senior vice president of legal and external affairs at McWane, Inc. Prior to assuming that role he served as senior vice president and general counsel for almost thirty years. Before working at McWane, Inc., Mr. Proctor was a shareholder of the law firm of Maynard, Cooper and Gale, PC in Birmingham, Alabama. He is a graduate of the University of Virginia and the University of Alabama School of Law. He also serves as the general counsel and on the executive committee for the Business Council of Alabama, the chair of the Policy Committee for the Birmingham Business Alliance, on EPA's National Drinking Water Advisory Panel, on the executive committee at Cornerstone Schools, and in many other civic and public policy roles. He is also a past chair of Manufacture Alabama's Iron and Steel Council.

ANNETTE FUNDERBURK, PRESIDENT, INGRAM STATE TECHNICAL COLLEGE

Annette Funderburk, MPA, leads J.F. Ingram State Technical College, providing quality postsecondary career and technical education to incarcerated adults and parolees in Alabama, aiding their reentry into society through job placement and community support. With prior roles at the Alabama Community College System and a decade in county administration, she brings a wealth of experience in economic development, policy, and criminal justice. Holding a Master's in Public Administration and being a 2017 Community College Fellow, Funderburk is an engaged community member, active in organizations such as the Rotary Club and various professional associations. Appointed by Governor Kay Ivey, she serves on the Alabama Prison Repurposing Commission and the Commission on Reentry, showcasing her commitment to correctional education and societal reintegration.

ALLISON MUHLENDORF, TOOTRIS

Allison Muhlendorf is the Director of Outreach + Government Relations at TOOTRiS, a pioneering platform that connects child care stakeholders—parents, providers, employers, and agencies. In this role, she establishes vital connections with employers, government entities, and early childhood organizations, while also expanding child care accessibility through community engagement. With a background including her tenure as Executive Director of the Alabama School Readiness Alliance, Allison significantly amplified Alabama's Pre-K program, elevating state investments from \$19 million to \$182 million and extending coverage from six to 47 percent of four-year-olds. Her advocacy and policy expertise extend to her work with Pre-K Now and the Children's Institute. Notable accolades include the Non Nobis Solum Award and recognition in Women Who Shape the State. Allison, a Willemette University alumna with a master's degree from the University of Maryland, resides in Montgomery, Alabama, with her family.

MICHELLE HURDLE, AIRBUS AMERICAS

With 31 years of experience in economic development, Michelle Hurdle transitioned to EADS in June 2008, where she engaged in economic development at state, regional, and local levels across Alabama, Georgia, and Mississippi. Joining Airbus Americas in 2012, Michelle played a key role in coordinating the establishment of the A320 Final Assembly Line in Mobile, Alabama, following her tenure as the economic development representative for PowerSouth Energy. A graduate of Troy State University with a Bachelor of Science in Geography and Social Science and the University of Southern Mississippi with a Master of Science in Economic Development, Michelle's educational journey includes training at the BASIC Economic Development Course at USM, the Economic Development Short Course at Georgia Tech, and the Economic Development Institute at the University of Oklahoma. Within her Airbus role, she also oversees the day-to-day management of Flight Works Alabama, an aviation education center situated on the Airbus campus in Mobile.

NICHOLAS SIMPSON, AIRBUS AMERICAS

Nick is a well established Director within Airbus with 20 years of work experience. Nick started at Airbus as an apprentice and has held various roles within the company. He moved to Mobile, Alabama in 2015 to establish Airbus's newest Final Assembly Line. His first focus was to establish a robust strategy to secure the operational performance here in our US Manufacturing Facility. In the last few years Nick switched his focus to workforce development activities and has been a key player in establishing a recognized registered Apprentice program and in the process securing the manufacturing resource requirements for the years to come.

Paul Perry has been with Warren Averett since 2004 and leads the Risk Advisory & Assurance Services Group, focusing on cybersecurity, risk assessments, and SOC engagements.
