





Funding Available for Co-op Placements

Thank you for your interest in NAIT's Bachelor of Business Administration Co-op Program!

Hiring a co-op student allows you to access funding to help subsidize the cost of the placement. The table below outlines the various funding options available.

Please note, students are typically paid \$10,000-\$12,000 per 4-month placement.
