- Businesses must bear a business license within SACC Board of Trade boundaries for at least one year
- $\cdot\,$ Businesses can not receive an award in the same category within the past five years
- Businesses can only stand for a single nomination category

PLEASE NOTE:

- Businesses/Individuals can nominate other businesses, or businesses can self-nominate
- A team of judges will interview each nominated business
- In order to qualify, nominees must participate in an interview with the judges
- Nominees will be contacted in advance to set up a time for the interview via Zoom
- Nominees will be asked to provide a team or business photo for the Awards of Distinction Ceremony program
- All businesses must meet the eligibility requirements for the award they choose to stand for
- If a business is nominated for multiple categories, the business will be contacted and asked which award (single) they wish to stand for
