Introduction

Island County is unique. From shipbuilding to farming, furniture making to medical device manufacturing, the county has a large mix of businesses and occupations with a broad scale of wages. Only information from a local level could possibly address this diversity. Data used in this report comes from the annual report of the U.S. Bureau of Labor and Statistics “Quarterly Census of Employment & Wages” and “Employment and Wages from Occupational Employment Statistics” survey for Island County.

A main theme in the Island County Comprehensive Plan is the need to create and attract living wage jobs (Development, 2008). That begs the question, “What is a living wage job?”

Before looking at living wages it’s important to consider poverty.

The US Census Bureau states, “The poverty threshold, or poverty line, is the minimum level of resources that are adequate to meet basic needs. The official measure uses three times the cost of minimum food diet in 1963 in today’s prices.” (US Census Bureau, 2017).

The table below shows annual wage federal poverty thresholds for 2017 (U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, 2019).

A living wage is defined as “self-sufficiency”. Diana Pearce, PhD, in her publication *The Self-Sufficiency Standard for Washington State* writes it “...means maintaining a decent standard of living and not having to choose between basic necessities — whether to meet one’s need for child care but not for nutrition, or housing but not health care. Self-Sufficiency Wages are family sustaining wages.” (Diana Pearce, 2001) Dr. Pearce’s report defines a wage for families to live and work without public or private assistance or subsidies.

This report uses the living wage calculator for Island County provided by the Massachusetts Institute of Technology and Dr. Amy K. Glasmeier, Professor of Economic Geography and Regional Planning, Head, Housing, Community and Economic Development Group (Glasmeier, 2019). The original calculator was modeled after the Economic Policy Institutes’ metropolitan living wage tool and is not meant to reflect middle class wages.

How to Read the Report

Two main areas make up the report – wages reported with one industry and those reported in an occupation across all industries. The North American Industry Classification Standard (NAICS) (U.S. Census Bureau, 2017) is used to show wages paid within a single industry and is listed in the “Business Wages” section. Specialty Occupation Classification Codes (SOC) (U.S. Dept of Labor, 2017) serve as the means to determine annual wages within an occupation and across multiple industries. For example, wages paid in the sector of “Hardware Stores” includes all workers in the store like cashiers, customer service representatives or department heads. “Retail Salespersons” in the “Occupation” report applies to people in the occupation who work in any store. The result is sometimes a large difference in the reported wage.

All wages refer to “annual wages” which reflects all compensation, including benefits. For example, the listed “poverty wage” is an annual wage.

The “Below Poverty” table starts with the “Sector” column and is according to businesses. Specialty Occupation Classifications appear later in the report. Instead of showing the annual wages for a “cashier” the NAICS report lists wages for a variety of store workers such as pet stores, plant nurseries and used clothing stores.

“Annual Wages” reflect the average compensation paid annually to an employee working in the business sector.

“Household Size” provides a breakdown of the number of children and adults and the equivalent annual “Poverty Wage” level.

Household sizes where the annual wage exceeds the poverty wage level do not appear. For example, “All other amusement and recreation industries” sector pays an annual wage lower than all the household size poverty level wages where beauty salons pay annual wages enough for all but the larger households.

Below Minimum Wage

In January 2019, Washington raised its minimum wage to \$12.00 per hour. Multiplying the minimum wage by the standard of 2,080 estimated work hours per year results in \$24,960. (In 2020, the minimum wage will be raised to \$13.50 per hour.) The “Below Minimum Wage” table lists those business sectors paying a total annual wage lower than \$24,960.
