



Shelby County Chamber of Commerce Adult Learner Community College Scholarship

Description: The Shelby County Chamber of Commerce will award scholarships to students currently pursuing postsecondary education at the Jefferson Community and Technical College Shelby County Campus (JCTC-SCC). This scholarship will be available to students pursuing technical education program pathways.

Scholarships must be used for tuition, books, lab and technology fees at JCTC-SCC. Students utilizing PELL for student's loans are eligible. Students utilizing work ready scholarships can use their scholarship for books fees not covered by the "Last Dime" basis or after. Any funds not utilized will be returned to the Chamber. Students making schedule adjustments prior to January 1, 2022 must inform the Shelby County Chamber of Commerce as well.

Requirements:

Applicants shall be residents of Shelby County.

Applicants shall have been enrolled in courses at JCTC-SCC for the spring 2021 semester.

Applicants must attend JCTC-SCC in fall 2021.

Applicants shall demonstrate high potential for career success. Two reference letters from faculty members shall be submitted. Letters should attest to the applicants' potential for success in their chosen career field or trade.

Applicants shall provide written explanation of your future career plans and the effect continuing your education will have on your quality of life. Applicants' names shall be on the written explanation, which should be typed. Applicants should address their intent to pursue their career in Shelby County Kentucky.

The completed scholarship application, advising unofficial transcript, consent to release forms from JCTCS and required attachments (reference letters and written explanation of career plans) must be postmarked by **November 1, 2021**. All funds will be held until final grades have been verified. All materials must be submitted in one envelope at the same time or the applicant will be disqualified.

Scholarship stipends are paid to the institution one time at the beginning of the first term and are non-renewable unless agreed upon in advance. The scholarship must be used during the year for which it was presented.
