They are hazardous because when released, spilled, or incorrectly used they have the potential to harm you, your pets or the environment. The unused or unwanted materials are known as Household Hazardous Waste or HHW.

- Used Motor Oil –accepted at several locations throughout Shelbyville.
- Explosives or Ammunition
- Radioactive Waste
- Infectious or Medical Waste
- Water Based Sealants
- Household trash
- Prescription Medication
- E-Waste (TV's, computers, printers, cellphones, vcr/dvd/cd players and other electronic items)
- No Business items
