EUROPEAN ECONOMIC FORECAST AUTUMN 2020

The European Commission recently published its Autumn 2020 Economic Forecast noting "[e]conomic activity in Europe suffered a severe shock in the first half of the year and rebounded strongly in the third quarter as containment measures were gradually lifted. However, the resurgence of the pandemic in recent weeks is resulting in disruptions as national authorities introduce new public health measures to limit its spread."
