Georgia IPAC allows our lobbyist to build relations with the State Leaders that are voting on important bills impacting our industry.

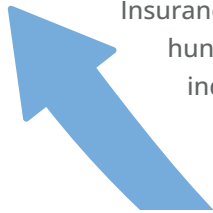


The Georgia insurance market is on the verge of collapse.
