Leadership Overland Park Educate & Elevate Scholarship

The Leadership Overland Park (LOP) Educate & Elevate Scholarship is designed to help in-need residents of Johnson County, Kansas gain a professional or technical career. **The award for 2022 will be \$500.** All applications must be received by 5:00 p.m. on April 20, 2022. The winner of the scholarship will be recognized at the annual Leadership Overland Park graduation on Thursday, June 16, 2022 (subject to change).

General Intent and Criteria for the LOP Educate & Elevate Scholarship Award:

1. Must be a resident of Johnson County, Kansas, as evidenced by the educational transcript.
2. Must be able to demonstrate high school / GED completion or proof of successful college acceptance and/or enrollment.
3. Pursue a career by earning a degree or technical certificate in health, social services, IT, life sciences, vocational skills or trades.
4. Selection will be prioritized based on need.
5. Scholarship to be paid to the institution for an undesignated use (i.e., books, tuition, meals, childcare, or miscellaneous).
