MUD VOLLEYBALL RULES

SERVING & POINTS

1. Scoring will be rally point system. Anytime time the ball hits the ground, a team will score. There are no “side-outs”.
2. The tournament is double elimination format and each team will be guaranteed 2 matches. A match will consist of best-of-three games. A game consists of 21 points or a 20 minute time limit. A team must win by 2 points. In the event of a tie at the expiration of time, team captains will have to mud wrestle for the victory. Just kidding. Whoever scores the next point wins.
3. The ball must be served from inside the pit from the right back corner and may be hit in any manner with the hand. The referee(s) will determine if a questionable serve is good. Come to think of it, if it was questionable in the first place, it was probably a bad serve anyway.
4. Prior to service, the ball may not be loaded with mud. Wipe off the excess mud.
5. It is illegal to block a serve.
6. Any serve that touches the net and is in bounds is considered to be “in play”.
7. Players of the serving team must rotate clockwise when receiving the ball to serve. Just follow the little hand around the clock face.
8. Before each ball is served, the serving team will call out the score.

PLAY

1. The court shall consist of a net and genuine Brady mud, and will be 60' x 30'.
2. Everyone participating must wear tennis shoes. Duct Tape helps keep shoes on player's feet. Protective eyewear is recommended, especially for those wearing contacts.
3. A team can have a maximum of eight players on the court at one time. At least three females must be on the court from each team at all times.
4. Any ball making a splash or splat is considered in-bounds. In-bound areas to be interpreted by individual referees prior to each match. Out-of-bounds is outside the pit. Mud is our friend.
5. All contact must be made within the pit. For safety purposes, stepping outside the pit is not allowed. Players must have one foot in the court at all times.
6. It is illegal for players to touch the net or an opponent. You don't want cooties from the other team anyway, so stay on your side.
7. Three hits are allowed per side. A player may not hit the ball twice in succession except for off of a tipped block.
8. A block is not considered a hit.
9. The ball must be hit. Holding, lifting, pushing, or throwing the ball while in play is not allowed. Come on, this ain't rocket science.
10. A ball may be played by any part of the body above the waist. All you soccer players are out of luck.
11. Only the front line is permitted to spike. It is a violation to spike with 2 hands ('cause it's like carrying the ball). Good luck getting out of the mud to spike in the first place.

12. Substituting will only be allowed by the serving team at the server's position, except in case of injury.
13. A player of the opposite sex does not HAVE to hit the ball in any turn. But he/she can and will be mad at you if you hog the ball all the time.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Officials will be provided.
2. *Fun, sportsmanship, and safety* are the top priorities of the tournament. Any other priorities will be given to you when we think of them.
3. Play is for fun, so unsportsmanlike conduct, arguing, and fighting will not be tolerated and you will be asked to leave the event. Failure to leave will result in your team forfeiting the game. Just be nice.
4. Tournament director decisions are final. There are no protests.
5. Any player arguing with or abusing an official will be asked to leave the game and immediate vicinity. Failure to leave will cause his/her team to forfeit the match.
6. A player ejected from a match may be allowed to participate in further matches. This will be up to the individual referee making the call and may be evaluated on a case by case basis.
7. No time outs allowed except in case of injury.
8. Tournament volunteers will act as referees, line judges, settle immediate disputes concerning game play, and keep track of tournament standings. Wow, busy people! So back off and give them a break.
9. Maximum of 10 players per team.
10. Players must be at least 13 years old to participate and must have parental consent if under 18.
11. All jewelry, watches, necklaces, rings, etc. are encouraged to be removed.
Tournament committee, volunteers, or any other persons are not responsible for your lost items. Just you.
12. Payout prizes to the top three teams will be based on the number of entries.
