r. Michael Todd Freeman has served as superintendent of Vestavia Hills City Schools since March 2018. From 2013 to 2018, Dr. Freeman was the superintendent of Sylacauga City Schools in east Alabama. Dr. Freeman also worked for twenty years in Auburn City Schools as a social studies teacher, high school principal, and executive director of operations and services.



As Vestavia Hills' superintendent, Dr. Freeman has overseen renewal of the school system's accreditation and the development of new strategic plan goals.

Dr. Freeman holds a bachelor's degree in education from Jacksonville State University, a master's in education from Auburn University, and a doctorate in educational leadership from Valdosta State Uni-
