r. Todd Freeman has served as superintendent of Vestavia Hills City Schools since March 2018. Now in his third year with Vestavia Hills City Schools, Dr. Freeman has led the opening of three new campuses, the implementation of new strategic plan goals, and the renewal of the school system's accreditation.



From 2013 to 2018, Dr. Freeman was superintendent of Sylacauga City Schools in east Alabama. He also spent twenty years in Auburn City Schools as a social studies teacher, high school principal, and executive director of operations and services.

Dr. Freeman holds a bachelor's degree in education from Jacksonville State University, a master's in education Auburn University, and a doctorate in educational leadership from Valdosta State University.

Dr. Freeman, his wife, Rachel, and two sons, Samuel and Jacob are residents of Vestavia Hills. Rachel is a group fitness instructor at Shades Valley YMCA. Samuel is a 1st grader and Jacob is a kindergartner at Vestavia Hills Elementary Dolly Ridge. Dr. Freeman is a member of the Vestavia Hills Rotary Club and Civitan International, and he and his family attend Shades Mountain Baptist Church.
