Dr. Freeman holds a bachelor's degree in education from Jacksonville State University, a master's in education from Auburn University, and a doctorate in educational leadership from Valdosta State University.

Samuel is a second grader and Jacob is a kindergartner at Vestavia Hills Elementary Dolly Ridge. 
