Now in his fifth year with Vestavia Hills City Schools, Dr. Freeman has led the opening of three new campuses, the implementation of new strategic plan goals, and the renewal of the school system's accreditation.

From 2013 to 2018, Dr. Freeman was superintendent of Sylacauga City Schools in east Alabama. He also spent twenty years in Auburn City Schools as a social studies teacher, high school principal, and executive director of operations and services.

Dr. Freeman holds a bachelor's degree in education from Jacksonville State University, a master's in education from Auburn University, and a doctorate in educational leadership from Valdosta State University.


