Mini profiles, including links to each member's website, are available to Chamber members. ### **News Updates**

The Chamber is an excellent source of business and community information and news. We consistently publish online information pieces such as:

- The Weekly Update is the Chamber's newsletter that reaches over 800 area business people, summarizing the week's events and member news.
- C.A.R.M.A. Report (Chamber, Area, Region, Michigan, America) A
  weekly publication with a short synopsis of current events with
  links for each category.
- Social Media The Fenton & Linden Regional Chamber's social media includes Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, LinkedIn, and YouTube. Members can share information such as Press Releases and upcoming events, offer specials, post photos, or get & give ideas to others that will help with their business. The Chamber regularly updates these virtual platforms with event updates, photos, and member news.

## Networking @ Noon

Different Chamber members host these events on the third Thursday of each month, from 11:30 am – 1:00 pm. These casual, friendly networking events attract a crowd averaging 80-100 who have found these get-togethers to be an excellent resource for contacting current and prospective clients. ### **Networking After Hours**

Held each spring and fall, Networking After Hours provides casual, friendly networking similar to Networking @ Noon. These gatherings of business representatives occur after the end of the business day, offering our members a chance to connect with business representatives throughout the county. These events occur at a different business location each time.

## New/Existing Member Representative Orientation

This semi-annual informational orientation is open to new and existing Fenton & Linden Regional Chamber members to review member benefits and reinforce and assist all in attendance in utilizing their membership to the fullest extent. These casual, low-key gatherings are held at the Chamber office and announced through the Chamber Weekly Update, email blasts, and social media.
