Interactive stations allowed

visitors to see high-tech tractors, ag drones and the science behind growing clean sugarcane seed. Chamber guests then toured Tellus, Florida Crystals' and Sugar Cane Growers Cooperative's newest joint venture, where former board member Matt Hoffman explained the innovation driving the use of sugarcane fiber to create eco-friendly tableware products.


