Trustees Tour Voting Equipment **Center in Riviera Beach**

Chamber Trustees engaged in an exclusive behind-thescenes look at elections in Palm Beach County with Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections Wendy Sartory Link. Supervisor Link discussed the recent election law changes in Senate Bill 90 that arose out of the 2021 Florida Legislative Session. Senate Bill 90 makes adjustments to Florida elections laws regarding voting by mail, voter registration requirements and new rules governing third-party voter registration organizations.

In addition, the Trustees took part in the Elections

Experience Tour, a guided tour at the Voting Equipment Service Center in Riviera Beach, where the Elections Office keeps the voting equipment and processes

ballots during an election. During the private tour, Supervisor Link explained how ballots are created. mailed, received, verified and tabulated in Palm Beach County elections.

The group visited nine separate learning stations where participants could see the equipment that processes the ballots and understand the protocols in place to ensure the integrity and accuracy of local elections. There was the added benefit of observing the equipment in operation. The tour was followed by a comprehensive question-and-answer period with Supervisor Link.
