

State of the County Breakfast

Palm Beach County Vice Mayor Gregg Weiss delivered the State of the County address on Thursday, Jan. 6, at the Chamber's monthly breakfast. Weiss highlighted several key initiatives of the county, including economic development, workforce housing and homelessness, environmental protection, public safety and behavioral disorders associated with substance abuse. The resounding conclusion

from the vice mayor: "the state of our county is good." Unemployment is at 3.5%, lower than the state and national average. Job openings at approximately 39,000 outnumber those currently unemployed in our county, which was just over 26,000 in November 2021. According to the 2020 census, the county has seen population growth of 13% annually, equating to roughly 1.5 million new

residents. To accommodate for the influx of new residents a transportation initiative dubbed the "5-Year Road Program" will add more roads, walking trails, community parks and additional traffic signals throughout the county. Weiss' call to action for those in attendance was focused on continuing to partner with the county on ways to improve local communities and focus on the issues that

impact residents, businesses and neighborhoods. "The opportunities are limitless when we work together as partners towards our shared goal of making Palm Beach County the premier county to live, work and play," said Weiss.
