TRANSFORMING WEST PALM BEACH

The chamber's June Breakfast "Transforming West Palm Beach" took place on Wednesday, June 29 at the Palm Beach County Convention Center. The sold-out event featured an expert panel of speakers: Gopal Rajegowda (Related Companies), Robert Frisbie (Frisbie Group), and Ned Grace (NDT Development). The panel spoke in detail on the newest developments taking place in West Palm Beach bolstered by the influx of businesses seeking to relocate here from other states.

At and around The Square, in the heart of downtown West Palm Beach, Related Companies has plans to create a vibrant, 360-lifestyle downtown with an eclectic mix of food, culture, brands and experiences helping to attract the best

companies and the brightest talent to come live and work here.

NDT Development's plans for the mixed-use "NORA" District, anchored by North Railroad Avenue includes streetscape beautification, infrastructure upgrades, reuse and development of more than 150,000 square feet of commercial space, as well as 1.9 million square feet of ground-up development consisting of a new hotel with ground floor retail as well as residential and office space between 10th Street and Palm Beach Lakes Boulevard.

Robert Frisbie reported that the population in South Florida is expected to reach 13.78 million by 2045. That's a 48% increase in population compared

to 2020 census numbers at 9.34 million, ranking Florida as the third most populous state by 2040. The luxury residential units being built to accommodate our growing population will have a variety of materials and textures, engagement with the surrounding streetscape, integration of landscape and architecture, balconies and bay windows, and distinct entrances.
