

## CALLED COUNCIL MEETING

The called meeting of the Baxley City Council was held on February 4, 2020, at 6:00 p.m., with the following members present: Mayor Tim Varnadore; Mayor Pro Tem Mickey Bass; Councilmembers: Betty Livingston, Santana Fryer and Adam Thomas.

Other city officials present were: Reid Lovett, City Manager; Reba Cash, City Clerk, David Gore, Special Project Manager and Chief of Police James L. Godfrey.

Mayor Pro Tem Bass gave the invocation.

Mayor Varnadore called the Baxley City Council to order on this the 4<sup>th</sup> day of January 2020, at 6:00 p.m., the purpose of this meeting is to hear public comments on a petition filed by Ag South Farm Credit, ACA, located at 2215 Hatch Parkway South, be annexed and establishing a Business Residential (BR-1) Zone in voting district #4.

There being no further questions or comments, Mayor Varnadore declared the public hearing closed.

Under other business:

Councilwoman Livingston made a motion to accept Hofstadter and Association recommendation to award the low bid from K-Dug for \$35,200.00 for emergency repairs on Harvey Street sewer line, which will be reimbursed by the CDBG Fund. The responding firms were:

K-Dug Underground Utility Company	\$35,200.00
Southeast Pipe Company	\$81,673.00
