

## REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Baxley City Council was held on October 24, 2018, at 8:30 a.m., with the following members present: Mayor Tim Varnadore; Mayor Pro Tem Esco Hall, Jr. Councilmembers: Betty Livingston, Mickey Bass, Pat Williams, Adam Thomas and Santina Fryer.

Other city officials present were: Reid Lovett, City Manager; Reba Cash, City Clerk; Alex Johnson, City Attorney; David Gore, Street Supervisor; Dale Sapp, Water Supervisor; and Chief of Police James L. Godfrey

Councilman Thomas gave the invocation

Councilwoman Livingston made a motion approving the minutes of the Regular Council meeting of October 10, 2018, at 8:30 a.m. This motion was seconded by Councilwoman Fryer and carried unanimously.

DeAnna Rudd, Executive Director of the Baxley Housing Authority gave a financial report for the Housing Authority. She also presented the Mayor with a check for the city in the amount of \$23,459.48 in lieu of taxes.

Councilman Bass made a motion approving the First Reading of an Ordinance on a petition filed by Shaun White, requesting the property located at 1750 Ben Carter Road, be rezoned from the current Business Residential (BR-1) to a Residential (RM-10) Zone in voting district 2. This motion was seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Hall and carried unanimously.

Mayor Pro Tem Hall made a motion to approve the request to purchase a New Pump at the WWTP approximate cost \$34,000.00. This motion was seconded by Councilwoman Livingston and carried unanimously.
