MINUTES

The regular meeting of the Baxley City Council was held on August 9, 2023 at 8:30 a.m., with the following members present: Mayor Tim Varnadore, Mayor Pro Tem Mickey Bass, and Councilmembers: Santina Fryer, Betty Livingston, David Gore, Adam Thomas, and Ora Hall.

Other city officials present were: City Manager Keri Orvin, City Attorney Alex Johnson, City Clerk Jessica McLellan, Public Works Director Wayne Mullis, Chief Jeffery Taylor, Investigator Anthony McNeal, John Thomas Kimbrel, and Mitchell Wilkerson.

Councilman Thomas led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Varnadore gave the invocation.

Councilwoman Hall made a motion approving the minutes of the Regular Council Meeting of August 9, 2023 at 8:30 a.m. This motion was seconded by Councilwoman Fryer and carried unanimously.

Councilwoman Livingston made a motion approving the minutes of the Budget Workshop of August 9, 2023 at 9:00 a.m. This motion was seconded by Councilwoman Hall and carried unanimously.

Councilman Gore made a motion to approve the second reading of an annexation ordinance for Nariel Roblero Berduo for property located at 146 Norman Circle be annexed establishing an RM-10 zone in voting district 6. This motion was seconded by Councilman Thomas and carried unanimously.

Councilwoman Fryer made a motion to approve the proposed list of roadways for the Speed Ordinance for the City of Baxley from the Georgia DOT. This motion was seconded by Councilwoman Hall and carried unanimously.

Mayor Pro Tem Bass made a motion to table "Discuss/Approve proposals for the purchase of a Grapple Truck" to gather more information. This motion was seconded by Councilwoman Livingston and carried unanimously.

Councilman Gore made a motion to buy-out the currently leased 2018 backhoe in the amount of \$55,564.00. This motion was seconded by Councilman Thomas and carried unanimously.
