New Program Launching!

The Chamber's Leadership 360 program provides a facilitated sounding board for non-competing business owners and leaders to present timely issues for structured group analysis and coaching. Cohort members will gain insight on relatable issues while building a trusted network of advisors and develop knowledge of new companies and industries.

Providers know how to care for children's bones, joints and muscles.




Woodbury Community Foundation Friends Fest April 28, 2023 John P Furber Farm 7310 Lamar Ave., Cottage Grove

2023 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION April 13 Deadline

The Woodbury Area Chamber of Commerce will award seven \$1,000 scholarships to 2023 high school graduates from the Woodbury area. One of the scholarships will be awarded to a student who is either employed or has a parent employed by a Woodbury Area Chamber of Commerce business member. A second scholarship will be awarded to a student pursuing a certificate or two-year degree.

Criteria:

- Student must be a 2023 graduating high school senior who is either a resident of the Woodbury area or graduating from a Woodbury Area High School.
- Student must be pursuing post-secondary education for a certificate to four-year degree at an educational or vocational institution in the summer or fall of 2023.

How to Apply:

1. Answer the following two essay questions (typed, no more than 1,000 words combined):

(a) What have you done to improve your community (volunteer position, job, school)?

(b) What are your educational ambitions and how will your future lifestyle improve the community in which you live?

2. Complete applicant information below.

3. Email, mail or deliver application materials to the Chamber Office by April 13. 2023:

Notification:

- Only students selected to receive the scholarships will be notified in early May. Recipients will be asked to volunteer at the June 5th Scholarship Golf Tournament at Prestwick Golf Course.
- Chamber representative will attend the school's award event, where possible, to make a presentation.
- Scholarship payment will be submitted directly to the educational institution. It is the recipient's responsibility to provide the chamber with name and address of the educational institution as well as proof of registration.
