Everyday Hero

Nominee must reside in the Woodbury area and shown outstanding public service to the community and/or has positively influenced another's life through compassion, kindness, generosity. Tell us about a person whose good deeds went above and beyond to help others.

Educator of the Year



Nominee must be a licensed PK-12 teacher at a public or private school within the Woodbury area, during the 22-23 school year. Nominee should exemplify outstanding service and dedication to the field of education as well as demonstrate commitment to student success by inspiring students of all backgrounds and abilities to reach their full potential.

Nonprofit of the Year

Nominee must be an active 501-C3 organization located or operating in the Woodbury area for a minimum of three years, a Woodbury chamber member in good standing and made a notable impact on the quality of life for those who live and work in the Woodbury area while adhering to their nonprofit mission statement (mission statement must be included with nomination).



Public Safety Worker of the Year

Nominee must be employed as a public safety worker with the Woodbury area and been involved in an event or circumstance that displayed heroism, community service, bravery or dedication in 2023.
