On behalf of the Greater Parkland Regional Chamber of Commerce members and staff, Chairman Richard Wong and the Board of Directors extend their deepest condolences to the family and loved ones of former Member of Legislative Assembly Erin Babcock, upon receiving news of her passing after a lengthy battle with cancer.

“One of the last times I saw Ms. Babcock was at the Coldest Night of The Year walk,” says Chairman Richard Wong. “The love and dedication that Erin had for her community was evident especially that night as she volunteered for the Parkland Food Bank. Erin will be remembered through the Chamber community as an advocate for the Spruce Grove-Stony Plain area. The dedication that she brought for this area during her time as an MLA will be forever remembered.”

Ms. Babcock has left a legacy through her accomplishments such as the replacement of the Stony Plain Central School, funding to the Meridian Housing Foundation, and important upgrades to the provincial highways 779 and 628.

Ms. Babcock was elected to the Alberta Legislature as MLA for Stony Plain in 2015 and served the community until April of 2019.

The Chamber would like to thank the Town of Stony Plain for their recognition of Erin’s life by flying the flags at half-mast at Town facilities April 27 to May 1, 2020 as a sign of respect to former MLA Babcock.
