

Today enjoy the masterpiece of Antonio Gaudi with a grand tour of the Sagrada Familia. Designed and built by Bocabella and Gaudi in 1882, this amazing Basilica is still under construction. Next, take some time to relax in the city to explore the shops and eateries of La Rambla. Barcelona's old city is, without a doubt, one of the finest in Southern Europe. This wide boulevard connects the Place de Catalunya, a busy square, to the **Monument a Colom**, a tall column erected in honour of Christopher Columbus.

Day 4 Tuesday, Sept. 19 Madrid

Overnight: Madrid Meals Included: B

This morning after breakfast, enjoy a quick train ride to Madrid and your guided walking tour, including the Mercado de San Miguel Market, a famous market where you can window shop all the food stalls. Take in the sights and distinct scents of aged cheeses, giant hocks of ham, fresh seafood, vegetables and unusual fruits. Another great foodie day - provechito! (proh-veh-cheeh-toh). Also, see Madrid's famous avenues and historic quarters. See the Opera, Puerta del Sol, Plaza Mayor and the Plaza de la Villa.

Day 5 Wednesday, Sept. 20

Day trip to Segovia
Meals Included: B

This morning continue your journey to Segovia. It is here that you will see one of the best Roman-era monuments - Segovia's incredible aqueduct with its 188 arches and length of 16 kilometres! As well, tour the famous Alcazar, a beautiful 11th-century medieval fort that inspired the design of Disney's castle.

Day 6 Thursday, Sept. 21 Toledo

Overnight: Madrid Meals Included: BD

Today travel to the medieval pink city of Toledo, located 70 km from Madrid and one of the oldest cities in Europe. Once the former capital of Spain, the beautiful architecture includes almost every period in Spain's history including; Arab, Gothic, Mudejar, Renaissance, and Baroque. Toledo is also famed for its production of iron products, especially swords and is renowned for its damasquinados, or damascene handicrafts and costume jewelry. Damascening is the Moorish art of inlaying gold or silver threads into black steel in a decorative pattern. The skill is used to decorate plates, earrings, bracelets and large pendants. End this day with your hands-on Culinary class of traditional Paella and Flamenco Show.

Day 7 Friday, Sept. 22LogroñoOvernight: LogroñoMeals: BL

Today, venture from Madrid to Logroño via a stop in Peñafiel, best known for the Peñafiel Castle. The town is full of deep excavated caves which were traditionally used to store the wine because of the constant temperature they kept all year round. These caves have chimney vents for ventilation and to evacuate the gases generated by the fermentation of the wine. Here you will see these chimney vents that dot the landscape and around the town and the castle. Continue to Santo Domingo dela Calzada. Discover Santo Domingo on a guided walking tour including a very special lunch with a selection of Riojas Wines. Continue to Logroño for your overnight.

Day 8 Saturday. Sept. 23 Logroño to Salamanca

Overnight: Salamanca Meals: B

This morning venture from Logroño in time for your mid-day tasting tour in La Guardia, the heart of Spain's **Rioja Region**. Here we will begin with one of our favourite wineries ~ the **Bodega El Fabulista**. After lunch we depart for Salamanca, with a history dating back to the Celtic era, it's known for its ornate sandstone architecture and for its famous University, one of the oldest in Europe.

Day 9 Sunday, Sept. 24 Salamanca to Pinhão

Overnight: Pinhão Meals: B

Ths morning enjoy your walking tour of Salamanca and some free time for shopping and lunch.

Pinhão ~ Today bid farewell to Salamanca and to España, as you venture into **Portugal and along the majestic Douro Valley**. Pinhão is located at the crossing of the Douro and Pinhão rivers in the very heart of northern Portugal's famous Port winemaking region and is considered the mecca for wine lovers. The Douro valley is the oldest wine region in the world, having been demarcated in 1756, and produces some of the best wines in Portugal. *Saúde!* Pronounced: Saw-OO-de Translation: Health When in the Douro Valley - taste the wine! Adega Cooperativa de Favaios has been one of the most prestigious wineries in Portugal since 1952. The spirit of cooperation of its 550 associates, allied to the knowledge of the "people of Favaios", has boosted the production of the Moscatel Galego Branco variety, making Moscatel de Favaios one of the most emblematic Portuguese wines. Experts think this Portuguese Moscatel wine would be a match made in heaven!

Day 10 Monday, Sept. 25 Pinhão / Douro Valley, Guimarães & Porto

Overnight: Porto Meals: B

As we continue through the breathtaking scenery of the Douro Valley, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, you will soon arrive at **Guimarães** known for its well-preserved medieval buildings like the hilltop, 10th-century Guimarães Castle, with its sweeping city views. After lunch, enter the seaside city of Porto. End this day with your city sightseeing walk with your guide, including the incredible Train Station ~ São Bento, and the Porto Cathedral. **Hotel** ~ <u>Hotel Boavista Porto</u>

Day 11 Tuesday, Sept. 26

Overnight: Porto

Meals: B

Today meet your local guide for a city walking tour, with an entrance into the Cathedral, and after lunch, where I recommend devouring the famous Francesinha sandwich. With a full belly, you are off the Calem Port Distillery for a guided tour and a few sips of this famous Port. Enjoy the rest of your free day in Porto with so much to do and see! Between so many choices, I would recommend a cruise along the Douro River, taking a tram ride or shopping for cork products. Day 12 Wednesday, Sept. 27 Óbidos & Lisbon, the city of seven hills.

Overnight: Lisbon Meals: B

After breakfast we depart by private coach to Óbidos, the preserved medieval town that is, without doubt, one of Portugal's most classic walled settlements. Walking the ramparts, you can enjoy the views of windmills, vineyards and the surrounding farmlands. Enjoy the rest of this day with your Lisbon city walking tour beginning in the Belem district, Lisbon's most monumental and historical area. It was from here that many famous explorers sailed off on their voyages. See the incredible Belem Tower and then visit the beautiful Jeronimos Monastery, built-in 1502 and the resting place of Vasco da Gama. Continuing on your tour to Alfama with its breathtaking views of Lisbon, walk along with the beautiful tile-lined alleyways of this medieval maze. Overnight in Lisbon. Enjoy your guided tour of the Sintra National Palace (Palacio Nacional De Sintra) the best-preserved medieval residence in Portugal, the palace was home to the country's ruling nobility from the 15th to the 19th centuries. After lunch, return to Lisbon for a free afternoon.

Day 14 Friday, Sept. 29 Cascais & Farewell dinner

Overnight: Lisbon Meals: BD

Today celebrate this great adventure, and spend your day exploring Cascais. Formerly a quaint fishing village and popular resort, once favoured by European nobility and kings in the early 20th century. Today it is a colourful town with elegant pedestrian streets, luxuriant villas, fashionable shops, and cafes and famous for its seaside, sandy beaches and calm sea. Inclelbration of a great adventure, we will celebrate with a Farewell dinner with the Portuguese traditionally prepared Piri Piri Chicken.

Castile-León is known as "the granary of Spain" because it has large fields of cereal crops growing throughout the central plateau, including wheat, barley, rye, sunflower and oats.

Portugal stands in 5th position among the world's major wine exporters, just ahead of South Africa and behind Italy, France, Spain and Australia.
