| Are an employee that has exhausted regular unemployment benefits. | Regular unemployment benefits already paid to you | - \$600/week on top of your unemployment benefits for any weeks paid in the future - Up to 13 additional weeks of expanded unemployment benefits | Request payment every two weeks or Wait to reopen your claim |
| <p>Are not working due to COVID-19 for one of the following reasons:</p> <p><i>** NOTE: You may be eligible for Employer Paid Sick Leave, Emergency Paid Sick Leave, Paid Family Medical Leave in these situations. Your employer must pay you these first. You are not eligible for any unemployment benefits at the same time you are being paid one of these leave types.</i></p> | | | |
