Rules Regarding Vehicle Entries and Insurance Requirements: To keep everyone as safe as possible, entrants are asked to ensure that *all vehicles* (*with the exception of farm tractors*) and drivers are licensed, registered and insured, and to have an increased awareness of vehicle proximity to walkers. Proof of Insurance must be submitted to the Chamber Office with entry form. With these and other safeguards in place, both parade-goers and entrants will be able to celebrate this exciting event safely. Thank you for your terrific support!

Parade Route: The parade route will begin going West at the intersection of Blueberry Street and S. Colony Way, turning left on to Alaska Street and will go through to the Palmer Pioneer Home, turning through the roundabout, exiting on Fireweed and continuing North on S Valley Way. The parade ends before Dogwood Ave, and you may turn right on Digwood to get to Cottonwood. Staging will be along S. Colony Way, between Blueberry St. and the Palmer Train Depot. If you'd like to display your float after the parade, please circle back around and park in the large parking lot on S. Valley Way next to the pavilion (across the street from the Visitor's Center/Palmer Museum of History and Art).

Entry Form Submission: Entry form with complete payment and insurance (if applicable) must be received via mail, delivered, or emailed (address: sabrenacombs@gmail.com) to the Greater Palmer Chamber of Commerce, 550 S. Alaska Street, Suite 101, Palmer, AK 99645, for receipt by 5 p.m. Thursday, December 10th, 2019. No entries will be accepted after that time.

Check-in Instructions: On the afternoon of the parade between 3:30 pm and 4:30 pm, all entries must check in with the parade coordinator at the vestibule area (inside the double doors) at the Palmer Railroad Depot. Please have your insurance and driver's license on hand. No numbers will be issued prior to 3:30 pm Saturday, December 12, 2020. The parade begins promptly at 5 pm. Please be to your staging number by 4:45 p.m.

Please Note: YOU MAY NOT THROW CANDY OR OTHER ITEMS FROM MOVING VEHICLES! This restriction is in place to protect spectators along the parade route. Candy, brochures, or other items may only be distributed by individuals walking along the parade route and handing said items to the spectators. Failure to abide by this safety restriction will result in denial of entry in future parades. Animals: Animals are always welcome in our parades. However, all entrants with animals must provide clean up immediately following the animal.

Prizes: First place ribbons will be awarded in each category. Cash prizes and ribbons will also be awarded for overall first, second and third place winners. All prizes will be mailed.
