

## **Basic Rules and Definitions:**

Players – Age 5 and up

Team – 1 player up to 3 players

1 player per challenge

Teams with multiple players must alternate challenges. No one player may complete two challenges in a row.

Each team will compete in all Round 1 Challenges (4 challenges).

Up to 24 teams may advance to Round 2 (4 challenges).

Up to 12 teams may advance to Round 3 (2 challenges).

Up to 6 teams may advance to Round 4 (2 challenges).

Up to 3 teams may advance to Round 5 – final round (1 challenge).

To advance teams successfully complete all Round challenges within the 60-second time limit.

In the event of a tie the team with the fastest time will advance.

All challenges will be attempted from a standing position.

All items for each challenge will be provided. No outside materials/items may be used.

### **Wild Card-**

The number of challenges successfully completed: 4:4, 3:4, 2:4, 1:4.

Teams with the fastest times on completed challenges still might advance to the next round.

Example: The next round can have up to 24 teams. Twenty teams successfully completed all the challenges. Your team successfully completed 3 out of 4 challenges. Five other teams also completed 3:4. From those 6 teams the 4 teams with the fastest times may advance.
