

Don't Forget to Post Injury and Illness Information

Between Feb. 1 and April 30 each year, all employers must post OSHA Form 300A, which summarizes the job-related injuries and illnesses that occurred in the previous year, per Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) recordkeeping mandates.

The summary must include the total number of job-related injuries and illnesses (which also have new recordkeeping requirements) that occurred in 2014 and were logged on OSHA Form 300.

To assist in calculating incidence rates, information about the annual average number of employees and total hours worked during the calendar year is also required. If



a company recorded no injuries or illnesses in 2014, the employer must enter "zero" on the total line. The form must be signed and certified by a company executive. Form 300A should be displayed in a common area where notices to employees are usually posted.

Also, please be reminded that employers with 10 or fewer employees and employers in certain industries are usually exempt from federal OSHA injury and illness recordkeeping and posting requirements.

WE'RE HELPING A HERO!

ike Henriksen, owner of Mike Henriksen Construction in Fairhope and 2015 president of the Baldwin County Home Builders Association (BCHBA), was unaware of Paul Douglas Rains Jr.'s situation when he decided he wanted to do something to help local soldiers who were returning home from serving their country, particularly those suffering from injuries.

"Each year, the incoming president of BCHBA sets a goal for something they want the association to achieve," explained BCHBA Executive Vice President Fran Druse. "Mike came to me in early 2014 and said he wanted the association to help out area veterans. Shortly after that, I got a call from Ben Trione, who told me that he was trying to help a local veteran who needed a home. He wanted to know if our association could help out. I put him in touch with Mike and things began to fall together."

Trione, whose family has deep roots in Daphne, had known Rains since PD was a boy. Trione's son and PD were close friends who spent lots of time playing in the wooded area next to Trione's home.

So Trione decided to see about buying five acres next to his house as a future homesite for Rains, his wife and their four daughters.

"I watched this boy grow up," said Trione. "He and my son often camped out near that land."

The next fortunate event happened the day after Trione asked to buy the parcel from Verla Wilters, widow of former Alabama Supreme Court Judge Harry Wilters. Mrs. Wilters called Trione and said she wanted to donate the land. Trione then began to seek funds for building the home from national organizations, but was advised that local outreach might yield faster results. At that point he got in contact with Druse at BCHBA.

In addition to Henriksen, many BCHBA members and others in the area have now taken up the cause of building a home for Rains. Attorneys at Stone, Granade & Crosby in Daphne provided all the legal work required to set up the Baldwin County Homebuilders Charitable Foundation [501(C)(3)], which has a goal of raising \$200,000. Additionally, Bob

Chatham, of Chatham Design Group in Fairhope, has provided house plans for the four-bedroom house the BCHBA plans to build for Rains. Others who have been very active in getting this project underway are BCHBA past presidents Eddie Youngblood, Robert Brown, Chris Farlow and Alex Cary. Brown also served in Iraq during the Persian Gulf War. Henriksen said that many BCHBA members are anxious to contribute time and materials once all the details of the project are decided and the necessary funds are in place.

"Giving back to the community is very important to our members, so it is not surprising to see such a high level of interest and support in this effort," Druse said. "We have built two Habitat for Humanity homes and helped with a number of projects in the community, Our members are known for standing up and helping out."

For Rains, this undertaking by Trione, Henriksen and other members of BCHBA, is beyond his wildest dreams. "It's just beautiful, it's amazing. I don't know how to thank you," he said upon seeing the plans for the first time, on May 28.

Henriksen responded that Rains is the one who deserves thanks. "Everybody involved feels like we are doing something for someone we really care about," he said. "We couldn't do what we do without people

like you, who serve our country."

MEET OUR HERO, PAUL DOUGLAS RAINS JR.

ifelong Daphne resident Paul Douglas Rains Jr. was just 17 when he joined the US Army. After shipping out on May 31, 2002, he underwent training in Alaska and became a member of the Army's Airborne Infantry. He served in Afghanistan without injury. But on Jan. 3, 2006, during his second tour of duty, this time in Iraq, he was critically injured by an IED (improvised explosive device).

While Rains (known by family and friends as "PD") was not aware of it at the time, he later learned that he had suffered shrapnel wounds from top to bottom on his right side, with one piece of shrapnel piercing his liver and one of his lungs. The wounds were so severe that his family was called and informed that Rains was not likely to survive.

"I don't know what happened in the field hospital, but they saved my life," he says. "God was with me that day."

In the weeks and months that followed, as Rains was first sent to a hospital in Germany, then to Walter Reed Hospital in Washington, D.C., and eventually returned to his hometown, he showed he is truly a fighter.

"The doctor at Walter Reed told me I wouldn't walk for three to six months," he recalled, "I told him I'd be walking in two or three weeks and he just laughed at me."

Rains got the last laugh two weeks later when he was able to take his first steps on his own again. Eventually he returned home to Baldwin County and went to work as an equipment operator until the pain from his wounds proved too difficult to overcome.




