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General Information

- Section 310.6, Residential Group R-5 "Residential Group R-5 occupancies shall include all detached one- and two-family dwellings not more than three stories in height with a separate means of egress and multiple single-family townhouses not more than three stories in height with a separate means of egress designed and constructed in accordance with the International Residential Code. (Some care facilities with limited occupants also apply).
- All other Residential Occupancies are under the IBC
- 5:23-6 Rehabilitation Subcode was adopted on March 6,2023 to reflect the 2021 I-Codes, 2017 ICC A117.1 and the 2020 National Electrical Code.
- Barrier Free ICC A117.1-2017 has changes including minimum dimensions for ADA
- Energy codes have extensive changes- Blower Door test now mandatory along with visual inspection. Per Bulletin 22-1 blower door testing is not required for additions.
- Section 5:23-6.5(e)11, 6.6(e)18 and 6.7(e)15 -when the work being performed creates or exposes the roof decking/sheathing or the framing of any wall, floor or ceiling, or roof assembly that is part of the building thermal envelope, any accessible voids in insulation shall be filled using the insulation R-values of the new energy tables R402.1.2 or Table R402.2.6 for residential and Table 5.5-4 or 5.5-5 for commercial.

2021 NJ International Building Code Significant Changes - IBC

Inc. height limitations & requirements, Puzzle Rooms, Section 3115 Intermodal shipping containers, requirements for mechanical access garages, 503.1.4 Occupied roofs/506.3.2 Minimum Frontage distance/508.4.4 Separation. Among other sections, these have been modified for clarity and to avoid mis-interpretation.
- Chapter 5 General Building Areas & Heights- Table 507.2.3 stainless steel fasteners within 300 feet of saltwater shoreline.
- Chapter 7 Fire & Smoke Protection- Miscellaneous clarifications to definitions
- Chapter 9 Fire Protection Systems-IBC 903.2.10 Group S-2 Parking Garages; 903.3.1.2.3

 Height Measurement; 903.3.1.2.2 -Corridors and Balconies in the Means of Egress;
 IBC 907.5.2.1.3 Audible signal frequency in Group R-1 and R-2 sleeping rooms.
 907.5.2.1.3.2 Smoke alarm signal in sleeping rooms
- Chapter 10 Means of Egress- many minor changes in addition to minimum illumination level for both exit and exit access stairways has been increased from 1 foot-candle to 10 foot-candles.
- Chapter 11- Accessibility- 1107.2 Electrical vehicle charging stations/1110.6 Bottle-filling stations.
- Chapter 14 Exterior Walls- 1404.3.1 Class I and II vapor retarders./ 1404.3.2 Class III vapor retarders.
