Attendance Requirements

Attendance is required at all 10-regular full-day sessions, orientation and the closing session in April. Additional projects may be assigned. Even though emergencies do arise, any participant missing more than four half-days will automatically be dropped from the program and no portion of the tuition will be refunded. Missing any portion of a half-day will be considered a half-day absence. In order to gain full benefit from the program, participants must attend the August Orientation and the April closing session. Those who are unable to attend should delay their application until the following year.

Session hours may vary slightly, normally the days begin at 8 a.m. and end by 4:00 p.m.

Selection Criteria

The goal of Leadership Callaway County is to identify existing or new leaders in the community who can assume a leadership role in determining the future of Callaway County. The program is targeted for individuals who are already recognized for their leadership potential.

The Selection Committee will objectively evaluate each applicant's leadership potential, sphere of influence, and demonstrated or expressed interest for constructive involvement in community affairs. The following will be considered in evaluating each applicant.

- Applicant's previous and current involvement in Callaway County
- Applicant's involvement in his/her own sponsoring business or organization
- Leadership potential
- Motivation/Attitude
- Education/Training
- Career Background/Work Experience

• Special Consideration (estimated time available for community work, potential for contribution to the community, representation of previously unrepresented segment of the community, ability to help create a more diverse class)

Class size is limited to 15 participants. Applicants are encouraged to reapply if not selected for this year's class.
