OFFICIAL RULES: Walla Walla Vaccine Lottery

Eligibility

Entrants must meet all the following criteria to be eligible for a prize

1. Entrant must be a legal citizen of Walla Walla County.
2. A. Entrants who are previously vaccinated must have received the recommended dose(s) of a CDC authorized and recommended vaccine. This includes Moderna (two doses), Pfizer-BioNTech (two doses), and Johnson & Johnson (one dose).

B. Newly vaccinated entrants must have received at least one of the above mentioned vaccines during the period of September 15, 2021 through October 31, 2021.
3. An official entry form must be filled out and submitted at the vaccination clinic or at the Chamber of Commerce office in order to enter. Individuals are not automatically entered into the lottery upon vaccination.
4. Entrants must be 18 years of age or older at the time of the drawing in order to be eligible.
5. Incarcerated persons are not eligible to win a prize. For purposes of this promotion, “incarcerated” means a person committed to total confinement in any state, federal, city, or county correctional institution or facility.
6. Employees of the Walla Walla Valley Chamber of Commerce, and members of the Vaccine Lottery Organizing Committee, and any spouse, child, brother, sister, or parent residing as a member of the same household with such employee or committee member, are not eligible to win a prize.

Verification

1. Proof of current Walla Walla County residency is required in order to claim a prize. Residency may be confirmed by presenting either a valid Washington driver’s license, a valid Washington identification card, or another form of government-issued identification that includes the person’s name, address, and photograph.
2. Presumptive winners will be selected from entry forms, voluntarily filled out at vaccination sites or the Chamber of Commerce office. Proof of vaccination status is required at the time of entry and may be requested again at the time a prize is claimed.

Prizes

All winners will receive \$1,000. Winners are responsible for all federal and/or state taxes and fees applicable.

Prize money will be divided into two pools. Roughly 80% of the total prize money will be eligible for entrants who receive at least one dose during the period of September 14-October 31, 2021. Roughly 20% of the total prize money will be eligible for entrants who were vaccinated previous to September 14, 2021.

Entry Period and Drawings

All entries must be received between the period of September 14, 2021 through October 31, 2021. Winners will be randomly selected from all eligible entries. Early bird drawings will be held on Friday, October 1. General drawings will be held on Monday, November 1. Number of prizes is dependent on donations to the lottery.

General Rules

Eligible individuals are limited to one entry per person. Prior to drawings, the list of entrants will be reviewed. Duplicate entrants will be disqualified and removed.

Eligibility of all winners will be verified after the drawing. Upon verification, winners will be contacted by the Vaccine Lottery Organizing Committee.

Prizes are limited to one (\$1,000) per individual. After their name is selected, entrants are no longer eligible for subsequent drawings. If a winner is randomly selected for a subsequent prize, an alternate winner will be chosen using the same process and the original winners.

In the event that a winner refuses the prize, cannot be located, or is deemed ineligible, another entrant will be randomly selected using the same process as the original winners. Alternate winners are subject to all vaccine lottery rules.

Privacy

Information submitted by entrants will be used for the sole purpose of choosing winners of the vaccine lottery, verifying their identity, and confirming eligibility. It is the sole responsibility of the applicant to ensure the information provided is complete and accurate.
