QUICK START STEPS

1. Visit the Paso Robles Chamber of Commerce (PRCC) Website

- a. The PRCC website has a number of resources available to help you plan, launch, manage and grow your business
- b. For further inquiries, the PRCC can be contacted at (805) 238-0506

2. Acquire a Home Occupation Permit

- a. Steps 3-4 are not required by the city to acquire a business license or home occupation permit but are required by the county
- b. The City of Paso Robles requires cottage food production to have a Home Occupation Permit

3. Determine Operation Class

- a. "Class A" CFOs must annually register with San Luis Obispo County public health agency
- b. "Class B" CFOs must receive an initial inspection and then register and obtain an annual permit from the San Luis Obispo County public health agency

4. Receive County Permit

- a. It is recommended that prior to applying for a business license the operation is inspected by San Luis Obispo's County Public Health Department

5. Apply for Business License

- b. Your business license may remain in a pending status until you are issued a building permit if your selected commercial location requires tenant improvements

6. Set-up a Meeting With the BEST
